What a year!

In 2024, NIPA focused on expanding our capacity. Thanks to the generosity of donors and supporters like you, we achieved significant milestones. This year, Pride in the Park became our largest event yet, drawing nearly 3,000 guests and almost 70 vendors. Attendees gathered to exercise their constitutional right to peaceful assembly and celebrate Pride!

In addition to curating vibrant expressions of queer joy and remembrance in Coeur d'Alene, your support has empowered us to hire a dedicated Outreach Coordinator who is actively engaging with our community. We have proudly supported regional Pride events, from the historic first-ever Pride in Bonners Ferry to the Palouse, Western Montana for Libby Pride, and Spokane Pride. We've also made our presence known at vital non-Pride events, such as the St. Vincent de Paul Housing Resource Fair, the Suicide Prevention Action Network 5K, and North Idaho College's Health and Wellness Fair, making our life-saving services increasingly accessible to those in need.

2024 marked the launch of Queer Connects, a monthly networking social designed to foster connections, support local allied businesses, and empower nonprofits through food and clothing drives. Together, we are building a more inclusive and compassionate community. In addition, NIPA consistently responded to service referral requests—including medical and mental health care and legal assistance—at an average rate of two per month. In June, the organically ally-led fundraiser "Thanks, Paul!" provided a critical morale boost for our entire community. Finally, in 2024, we mobilized volunteers to form a grants team, enabling us to pursue more opportunities for much-needed funding.

At NIPA, we firmly believe in the power of unity. Our collective strength has led to significant advancements for the LGBTQIA+ community in North Idaho. The unwavering support from our allies, dedicated volunteers, and generous donors has been instrumental in our successes. We deeply appreciate each and every one of you, and together, we will continue to make a remarkable impact.

In 2024, our volunteers and donors truly emerged as the real rockstars. Their generosity enabled us to make a significant leap towards securing NIPA's long-term financial stability through the creation of our Pride Endowment Fund. This exciting development signals to our community that we have matured as a nonprofit organization and are committed to staying for the long haul!

NIPA's primary goal at this juncture is financial sustainability. While we are immensely grateful for the growth we've witnessed over the years, it's vital to ensure these funding streams remain steady moving forward. We recognize that the recent changes in our nation's political landscape will make our work more challenging, especially here in North Idaho, where the Idaho Legislature continues to blatantly attack LGBTQIA+ civil rights. Despite these challenges, we remain hopeful and are actively fostering new relationships with donors, businesses, and organizations in our region to ensure we can continue our critical work. This is why the creation of our Pride Endowment is so important for our small nonprofit - solidifying our existence for years to come.
